# Introduction to Nochex

## Nochex and its services

Nochex are a UK based, independently-owned provider of secure online payments. Established in 1999, the company's payment system is now installed into thousands of websites and integrated into a significant number of software packages.

Nochex's Seller and Merchant accounts offer different functionality, however both allow the user to accept e-money online payments without the need for a special internet merchant bank account or payment gateway. By replacing these two costly services with an all-in-one e-Money account, and backed up by friendly and responsive customer services, Nochex's customers can focus on building their online businesses.

The Nochex system allows its account holders to accept the following credit and debit cards:



Mastercard, Visa, Switch, Solo, Maestro, Visa Electron, Visa Delta

## Why customise the Nochex Payments Page?

You have successfully integrated the Nochex Payments Page with your website, but the redirect to the Payments Page is somewhat disjointed between the design of your website and that of the Payments Page. Customising the Payments Page allows you to offer a seamless transition in design. This not only gives your website a more professional look, it also instils confidence in your customer's that you are a reputable company.

Customisation allows you to:

- Enter your own Header and Footer HTML
- Edit Font types and colour
- Edit the Background colour
- Add your own Continue, Make Payment, Cancel and Start Again buttons
- Set your required Cancel, Success and Call Back URLs
- Add extra Merchant IDs

This guide will discuss the various parameters used when customising your payments page and also offer some examples of what can be achieved with this useful feature.

# Customisation Step-by-Step

## Customisation Step-by-Step

1. Login to your Nochex account.
2. Click on Payments Page Setup.
3. You will be taken to the following page:

4. Select your required Merchant ID from the drop down field. If you have more than one website you can add extra Merchant IDs to allow for differing customisations. To add a Merchant ID click on the Merchant ID button:
  - **Merchant ID:** You should enter a word for example 'shop2'; email addresses are not accepted as IDs. **NB:** Letters, numbers, and underscores (\_) only
  - **Merchant Description:** This is the description which is displayed on the NPP.
5. Once you have selected your Merchant ID, you can then edit the Header/Footer HTML, select fonts, colours and which buttons are displayed. The next page details the customisation parameters individually.

If you do not edit the Payments pages, the default Nochex Payments Page will be displayed. Once you have made changes to your Payments Page you will need to save the changes; your customers will then be shown your customised Payments Page. You can click on the Preview button to preview any changes you have made.

### Recommendations:

Where possible, images should be hosted on a secure server.

There is no limit to the size of the images, since they are served from your server; however if the file is unsecure it is loaded through our service which will take time for larger images.

If you are using a stylesheet then you must either link to a securely hosted stylesheet or alternatively embed the stylesheet within the header HTML.

# Customisation Parameters

## Technical Section

### Customisation Parameters

Parameter Name	Parameter	Description
Description	description	The “friendly” name for your Merchant ID. This is what your customers will see when making payments to you. E.g. the default for this would be your email address, this allows you to change it to your company name
Header HTML	header_html	HTML that will be displayed before the Payments page HTML elements are displayed. This can be used to customise the Payments page to look like your web site.
Footer HTML	footer_html	HTML that will be displayed after the Payments page HTML elements are displayed. This can be used to customise the Payments page to look like your web site.
Font Name	font_name	The style of the font used on the Payments page.
Font Colour	fore_colour	The font colour used on the Payments page.
Background Colour	background_colour	The background colour used on the Payments page.
Continue Button	continue_button_image	The location of image used when displaying the “Continue” button on the Payments page.
Make Payment Button	makepayment_button_image	The location of image used when displaying the “Make Payment” button on the Payments page.
Cancel Button	cancel_button_image	The location of image used when displaying the “Cancel” button on the Payments page.
Start Again Button	startagain_button_image	The location of image used when displaying the “Start Again” button on the Payments page.
Cancel URL	cancel_url	The URL that your customer is directed to if they decide to cancel the payment. The cancel button is only shown on the Payments page if this parameter is set.
Call Back URL	callback_url	The URL that Nochex will send a notification to once a successful payment is made. At this stage the APC functionality that you may currently be using is unchanged.
Success URL	success_url	The URL that your customer is directed to once the payment has been successfully completed.
Auto Redirect	auto_redirect	If this option is enabled then your customer will be automatically be redirected to the Success URL once the payment has been successfully completed.

## Form Parameters

### Posting Customisation Parameters

It is also possible to customise your Payments page by passing the HTML as part of a Form POST or Form GET rather than using specifying the HTML in your Control Panel.

**Please Note:** If you pass the parameters as part of a Form, then this method will take precedence over any changes you have made from with your Control Panel.

## Example 1

### Customisation Example 1

The easiest way to customise the NPP is to change the logo which is displayed. To do this you just need to enter the location of your chosen image, where the text is highlighted in red below; for example change <http://www.yourwebsite.com/images/header.gif>
